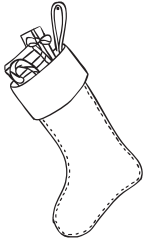

# CHRISTMAS CUSTOMS AND TRADITIONS



## THE ADVENT CALENDAR

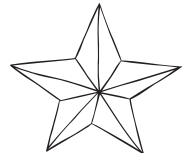
The Advent Calendar has 24 windows. Children use it to count down the days to Christmas Day. They can open one window every day. The first day must be December 1<sup>st</sup>. When you open the windows of the Advent Calendar, you find a chocolate or a small gift.

## BAUBLES

Baubles are glass decorations that people hang on Christmas trees. They have different colours and designs. In the USA, you can buy baubles with designs of your favourite musician or sports team.

## PRESENTS

All around the world, children get presents for Christmas. In some countries, Santa Claus brings the presents, but in others the gifts are from the Three Kings or an old witch. The presents are put in different places: in shoes, stockings or under the Christmas tree. In Poland, children open their presents on Christmas Eve, after the evening meal. In the UK and the USA, everybody opens their presents on Christmas Day.



## SANTA CLAUS

People believe that Santa Claus lives in the North Pole. He makes toys there with the help of Christmas elves. He also watches children and checks if they are good or naughty. On Christmas Eve he travels around the world and brings presents to all of the good boys and girls. The naughty children get coal from Santa.

## CHRISTMAS STOCKINGS

Christmas stockings are red. Children hang them by the fireplace. Santa Claus puts small gifts into the stockings. These can be oranges, chocolate coins or small toys. In some families, the gifts in the stockings are from Santa and the gifts under the Christmas tree are from the parents.

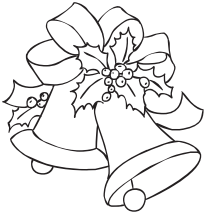
